

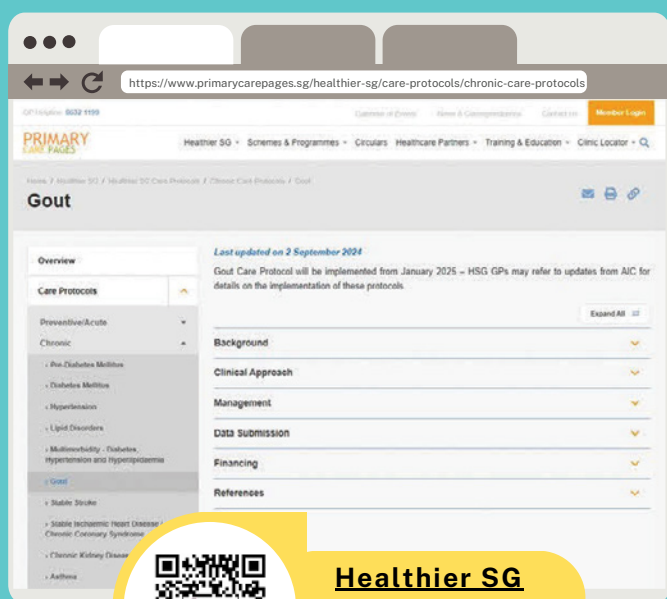

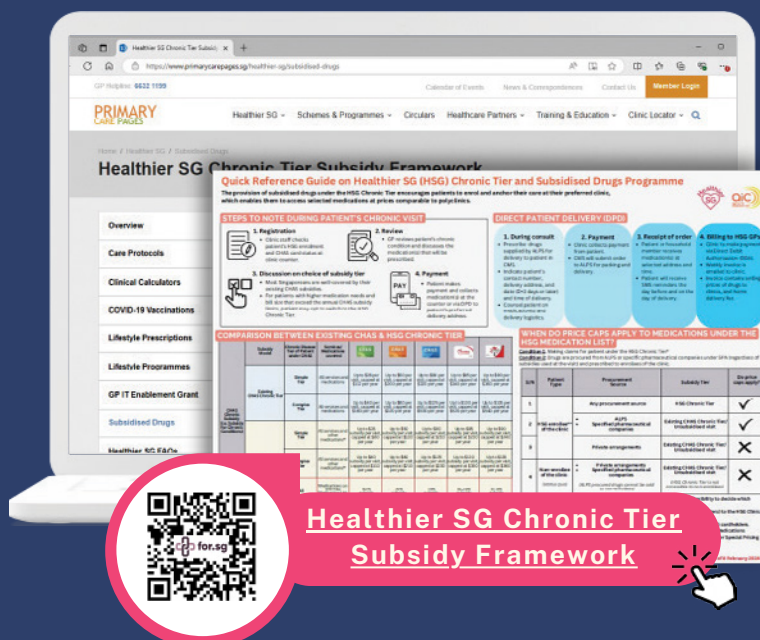
INFORMATION ON THE 6 NEW HEALTHIER SG CARE PROTOCOLS

The 6 new Healthier SG Care Protocols (Gout, Stable Stroke, Stable Ischaemic Heart Disease, Chronic Kidney Disease, Asthma, and Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease) have been implemented on 1 January 2025. To support Healthier SG GPs, we have published these new Care Protocols on Primary Care Pages, which include clinical approach, management, data submission, and financing.

The initial set of Healthier SG Care Protocols have also been updated to ensure that providers have access to the latest information.

RESOURCES ON HEALTHIER SG CHRONIC TIER SUBSIDY FRAMEWORK

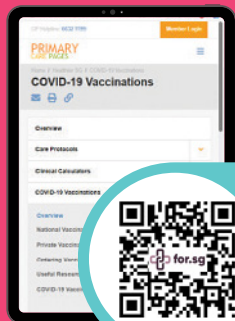

ENHANCED SEARCH FUNCTION IN THE CIRCULARS & CORRESPONDENCES REPOSITORY

The 'Circulars & Correspondences' search function has been enhanced to help users easily locate relevant content using keywords. For example, if you would like to search for all communications from MOH and AIC related to the Vaccinations and Childhood Developmental Screening Subsidies (VCDSS), simply enter 'VCDSS' in the search bar. Other useful keyword examples are 'CDMP', 'CHAS', 'Influenza' and 'COVID'.



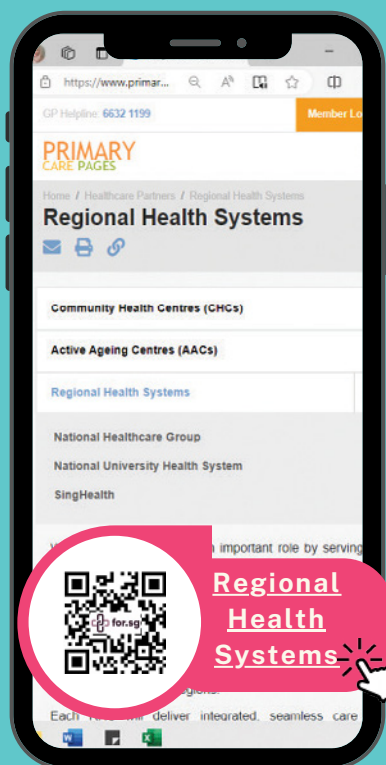

INFORMATION ON PROGRAMMES AND EVENTS BY THE REGIONAL HEALTH SYSTEMS

While family doctors play an important role by serving as the first point-of-contact for the acute and chronic care needs of their patients, the 3 Regional Health Systems (RHS) – the National Healthcare Group, National University Health System, and Singapore Health Services – serve as regional health managers to care for the health of the residents living within their respective regions.

Each RHS will deliver integrated, seamless care for approximately 1.5 million residents and coordinate services provided by family doctors and other health and social care partners, guide the development of referral pathways and cater to the health and social needs of residents, ensuring that residents remain healthy across different stages of life.
